At On Track Education Westbury, British Values are woven through our TRACK values (Trust Resilience Ambition Community Kindness) and thus everything we do. They help our students grow into confident, respectful, responsible young people who can thrive in modern Britain and develop into the best version of themselves in the local, national and global community. Whilst our students follow a British Values qualification pathway, these values are not taught in isolation—they are lived, modelled and reinforced across our curriculum, our relationships and our daily routines.

Democracy

- Students learn that their voice matters. We build opportunities for choice, collaboration and shared decision-making, helping students understand how democratic processes work and why they are important. Student leadership opportunities such as our Student Council, enable student voice to be an integral part of the OTW community.

Rule of Law

- Clear boundaries, consistent expectations and restorative approaches help students understand the purpose of rules and the importance of fairness, safety and responsibility.

Individual Liberty

- We encourage students to make positive choices, express themselves safely and develop confidence in who they are. Our nurturing environment helps OTW students understand rights, responsibilities and safe decision-making.

Mutual Respect

- Respect is at the heart of our culture. We model kindness, active listening and empathy, helping students build healthy relationships and value the perspectives of others.

Tolerance of Different Faiths and Beliefs

- Through our curriculum, tutor time engagement activities, celebrations and daily interactions, students learn about different cultures, religions and worldviews. We promote curiosity, understanding and inclusion so every child feels valued.
