YEAR 7

Students complete the transition Future Skills questionnaire, to identify the different levels of careers knowledge. Careers input from PHSE and other subject areas.

YEAR 8

Students given access to Xello to broaden career ideas and gain access to labour market information. PHSE lessons cover careers and other subject areas have an element of careers which is delivered throughout the year. Outside providers and speakers are invited in to speak to students, where appropriate.

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YEAR 9

Student complete the FSQ for the end of key stage three. Continue with Xello and careers input from all subject areas. Outside providers and speakers invited in to speak to students, where appropriate.

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YEAR 10

All students are given careers advice and formal careers interviews to begin the conversation of Post 16 planning. Continue with Xello and complete FSQ. Work experience, where appropriate, is organised. Outside providers and speakers invited in to speak to students, where appropriate. College taster visits can be organised.

YEAR 11

Applications are made to colleges. Outside providers and speakers invited in to speak to students, where appropriate. Ongoing careers advice from Post 16 team and interviews take place to secure post 16 placements. Additional careers interviews for all students if needed from the Post 16 Team. Continue with Xello and complete final FSQ. College taster visits can be organised.
